## **Directions to HoneybeeLives Apiary in New Paltz**

From NYS Thruway (Rt 87) take Exit 18. After passing thru tollbooth, turn left at light onto Rt 299, traveling west through town. After 4 lights and approximately 2 miles on Rt 299 (which is also Main Street) you will see Water Street Market on the left hand side. Just after the Market and before the Wallkill River Bridge, turn left onto Water Street. At the STOP SIGN bear right onto PLAINS ROAD. Go approximately one mile. The house is a small golden house, hidden by tall pine trees on the right hand side of road. The first part of the looped driveway starts opposite a cluster of five mailboxes that are on the left side of road. There is a small yellow honeybee sign on the tree at the first entrance and a plastic yellow "slow bee" at the second entrance. Pull up around the driveway as far as you can to make room for other cars. Some cars can park along the tree-lined part of driveway allowing others to pass. Please watch out for the chickens and our sweet dog and cat while driving thru the property.

From the west: Follow Rt 299 towards New Paltz. Immediately over the Wallkill River Bridge at the foot of town, turn right onto Water Street just before the Water Street Market. At the STOP SIGN bear right onto PLAINS ROAD. Go approximately one mile. The house is a small golden house, hidden by tall pine trees on the right hand side of road. The first part of the looped driveway starts opposite a cluster of five mailboxes that are on the left side of road. There is a small yellow honeybee sign on the tree at the first entrance and a plastic yellow "slow bee" at the second entrance. Pull up around the driveway as far as you can to make room for other cars. Some cars can park along the tree-lined part of driveway allowing others to pass. Please watch out for the chickens and our sweet dog and cat while driving thru the property.

Please note that summer traffic on Rt 299 can be quite crowded on weekends. If you have a navigational device, and you are coming from the east, you can bypass town traffic by taking a left at first traffic light over the thruway on Rt 299 (onto S. Putt Corners). Hopefully, your instrument will guide you correctly. Call Grai if you get lost.
