Our most important pollinators.

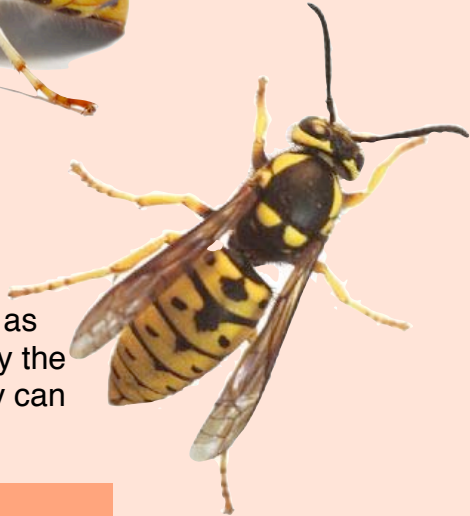
Honeybees do no structural damage. They look for cavities to build their home in. They survive over the winter as a community. They are not aggressive.

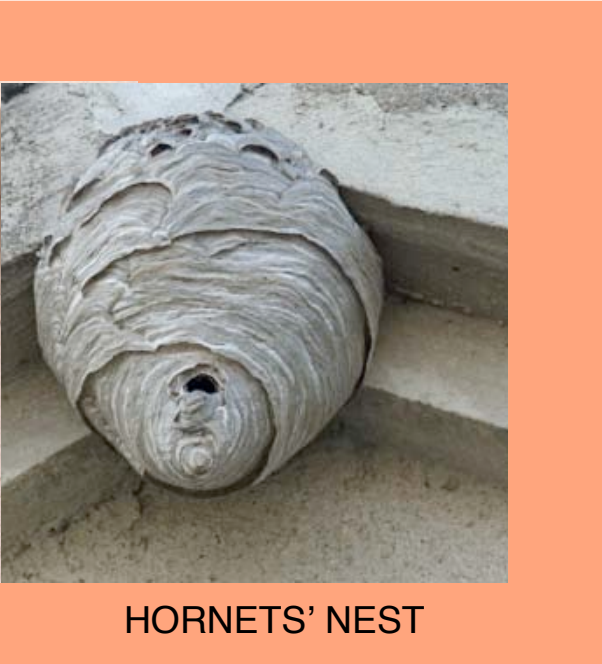


YELLOWJACKET
